The nun Theodora, Abbot of the Holy Monastery in Botesti, Romania, has an impressive history.

She worked as a journalist, a television producer known well in Romania, and decided to follow the Lord's call and turned to monasticism.

In an interview with AS, Theodora describes how she did this great step toward monasticism, enjoying a life of high social standing, increased income and awareness.

At one time, according to her words, she was filming a documentary about the monastic life in Romania, leading to all the monasteries in the country. "There was a desire for me to dedicate my life to the Lord," she stressed and described the role she played in her decision to meet her father, John, with whom she had many spiritual discussions.

"After finishing my film, I was on a short holiday in Moldova and I went with two friends to the Monastery of Sichastria. Then I met him. He stood for a moment in front of us, looked at us deeply and said, "And you, come, hurry, there is no more time. The bus comes and you have to go up

there. If you wait, you will have no place." And he left. I was wondering. What did he mean? It seemed to me that his words were prophetic..."

"I sat and thought and realized that I felt in my life, the desire to get away from what I did. That's how it all started."

REMINDERS: <u>NO KNEELING</u> until the Kneeling Prayers of Pentecost Sunday. Instead of "Vechnaya Pam'yat" at the end of a Parastas or during a funeral service *until Ascension Thursday*, we sing "Christ is Risen!" Also, we do not say the prayer to the Holy Spirit "O Heavenly King" until Pentecost Sunday.
